The Priority of Fervent Prayer Text: Matthew 6:5-13 October 5, 2024

Big Idea: To seek first God's kingdom, fervent prayer must be our priority.

Context is key! Question #1 (Context)

Ask Yourself: What is going on in the text?

- a) What is the setting and what is happening?
- b) Who are the main characters?
- c) Are there any words/phrases that are repeated?

Question #2 (Context)

Ask Yourself: What does the text says about God and about me?

- a) Is God saying or showing something about Himself? If so, what?
- b) Is God saying or showing something about us? If so, what?
- c) How does the text point to my need for Jesus?

To seek first God's kingdom, we must pray with a...

Point 1: Single FOCUS: God's HEART (vv. 5-6)

Question: Kingdom prayers are marked by humility. Are you posing or pursuing?

Question #3

- a) Rd vv. 5-6: Why did Jesus call out many of the Jews as hypocrites?
- b) Are you ever tempted with a divided desire in prayer? If so, what areas are most tempting for you?

To seek first God's kingdom, we must pray with a...

Point 2: Single PURPOSE: God's GLORY (vv. 7-13)

Question: Kingdom prayers prioritize God's glory. Whose kingdom are you seeking?

Question #4

- a) How should it impact our prayers knowing that our Heavenly Father knows what we need before we ask?
- b) How does this truth move our prayers from seeking my kingdom to seeking God's kingdom?

Question #5

- a) **Rd v. 10:** What does Jesus mean when He says we must pray, "Your kingdom come, your will be done on earth as it is in heaven?"
- b) Whose kingdom do your prayers primarily reflect you want to see built?
- c) What area(s) are you most likely to seek your own kingdom over the Lord's? Why those ones?
- d) How does the gospel free you from needing to pursue those things as first priority?
