- d) How does the text point to my need for Jesus? How?

Question #3

- a) Rd vv. 1-7: How did Paul know that these 12 men were not true disciples of Jesus?
- b) Rd John 15:4-8: What does Jesus say is the proof that a person is truly His follower?
- c) Why is the fruit of one's life the proof of a transformed heart?
- d) Why is it impossible to be saved by Jesus and not be transformed by Jesus?
- e) Look up and share Scriptures that tell what the fruits of the Holy Spirit are in one's life.

- a) What is our part in bearing fruit for the glory of God? Do we do nothing in the process? (Hint: Ephesians 4:1-3, Philippians 2:12)
- b) What are two kinds of spiritual fruit that you would like to see increasing in your life? What is a next step you can take to "work out" your salvation and partner with the Holy Spirit to grow in these areas?
- c) Spend time in prayer as a group praying for one another and follow-up this week.
