## The Gospel of the Blessing Text: Numbers 6:22-27 May 24, 2025

Big Idea: God freely gives us what we need most as a gift, and it will satisfy us for eternity.

# Context is key! Question #1 (Context)

Ask Yourself: What is going on in the text?

- a) What is the setting and what is happening?
- b) Who are the main characters?
- c) Are there any words/phrases that are repeated?

### Question #2 (Context)

Ask Yourself: What does the text says about God and about me?

- a) Is God saying or showing something about Himself? If so, what?
- b) Do the words in the text predict, prophesy or picture something about Jesus? If so, what?
- c) Is God saying or showing something about us? If so, what?
- d) How does the text point to my need for Jesus? How?

#### Question #3

- a) Why was this blessing particularly meaningful for Israel in the wilderness?
- b) How does the blessing reveal God's heart towards His people?
- c) How might knowing that God delights in blessing you change your approach to daily challenges and difficulties?

Point 1: It's a GIFT (vv. 22-24)

#### Question #4

- a) The sermon states that "God freely gives us what we need most as a gift.' How does this reflect the nature of the gospel?
- b) How is this different from how we often approach our relationship with God?
- c) In what area(s) of your life do you find yourself trying to earn God's blessing or approval?
- d) How must this passage reshape your thinking in those areas?
- e) Spend time in prayer with your group over those areas.

## Point 2: It <u>GIVES</u> us what we Need <u>MOST</u> (vv. 24-26) Question #5

- a) What does it mean that God's face shines upon us?
- b) How does God give us His 'smile' through the person and work of Jesus?
- c) Why is experiencing God's 'smile' described as our deepest need?
- d) What would you say is your greatest need right now based on your priorities, and what your time, resources and energy are going towards?
- e) How does the blessing point us to how the gospel fulfills that need?

#### **Question #6**

- a) What practical difference should it make in your relationships if you truly believed that God's face is shining upon you and the people around you?
- b) How should this fuel us on mission in going and sending to make disciples?

## Point 3: It's a PREVIEW of what's to COME (vv. 24-27) Question #7

- a) The sermon discusses the "already but no yet" concept. What aspects of this blessing do you experience now, and what aspects do you still await in their fullness?
- b) The sermon states, "One day we will see God's glory fully, and it will deeply satisfy our souls." How MUST this future hope affect how you live on mission today?
- c) Let's get practical: How IS this hope affecting how you live on mission today? Where is your eternal perspective in need of a refocus?
- d) Discuss how Jesus lived perfectly with this eternal perspective during His earthly ministry.
