Context is key!

Question #1 (Context)

Question #2

Time for some theology about faith!

- a) **Rd Heb. 11:1:** What is biblical faith?
- b) **Rd Romans 4:20-21:** What are the “things hoped for” and the “things not seen” that we are to have assurance in and conviction of?
- c) **Rd Heb. 12:1-2:** Who is the only One the power for biblical faith can come from?
- d) **Get Practical:** What does living in biblical faith look like on a daily basis (ie-walking by faith not sight)?

Question #3

- a) **Rd vv. 1-10:** Discuss as a group the work of God’s sovereign hand in what is happening here.
- b) **Rd Heb. 11:23:** Why could Moses’ parents take this step of faith?
- c) Why is a fear of the Lord over a fear of anything else essential if we are to walk by faith and not by sight?

Question #4

Note: Please use your fruit to root diagram for this question.

- a) Go back to your response to **question 2e**. What are you fearing more than God that leads you to walk in unbelief in those situations?
- b) What lies are you believing that are leading to that fruit of fear?
- c) What is it you really are idolizing in those moments?
- d) What are the ‘not seen’ gospel assurances that you must believe to overcome those fears (Give specific verses)?
- e) From those verses, what truths do you need to stand on in faith to overcome the lies you believe?
- f) Identify one next step you can take this week to live with the gospel fruit that comes from the truth.
- g) Spend time as a small group, repenting of each area of unbelief (fruit, lies, root) and then asking the Lord for the faith and power to walk by faith in the gospel and not by sight in those moments.

Question #5

- a) **Rd vv. 11-15:** Who was Moses trusting in when he responded by killing the Egyptian? How do you know?
- b) What situation(s) are you most tempted in to put your confidence in yourself and not the Lord (ie- You are trying to be God)? How does that end up for you? How did it end up for Moses?

Point 3: True Faith _____ out of _____ (vv. 16-25)

Question #6

- a) **Rd vv. 16-25:** Why did God need to send Moses into the wilderness? What was the main lesson He was going to teach Moses?
- b) How is God's breaking of Moses and sending of him into the wilderness such a loving gift for him?
- c) What does the Lord want more than us just getting out of the brokenness or wilderness?
- d) Think of a testimony you have of where God has graciously taken you into the wilderness, broken you and then used that for His glory in your life (Perhaps you are in this season right now!). Be prepared to share your testimony with your group to encourage one another in the Lord.
