- a) **Rd Matt. 9:35-38:** Look at the three responses listed above. Which of these are you making a priority in your life? Which are not a priority?
- b) What is one next step that you can take this week to grow in each of those areas as you seek to proclaim the gospel? Get specific!
- c) Spend time in prayer as a group for one another in those areas, and repent of your lack of compassion for the lost God has put around you.
